In the CAL, Reed committed to develop a Plan to evaluate the reactor fuel cladding; to communicate this Plan to the NRC; and to obtain NRC concurrence prior to implementing the Plan. Also, Reed committed to refrain from manipulating the reactor control rods and from taking the reactor critical until the cause of the radioactivity release was understood, was communicated to the NRC Region V office, and received NRC concurrence. Reed has submitted such a Plan, and by this letter the NRC concurs in that Plan. Reed has informed Region V that the probable cause of the radioactivity release was a pinhole-sized leak in the cladding of one of the fuel elements. dated March 17, March 30, and April 8, 1992, Reed has described a plan for i ting the leaking fuel element. Based upon our review of the Plan, as revi. J, and on discussions with Reed's Reactor Director, we concur in the Plan to locate the leaking fuel element, recognizing that it will be necessary to take the reactor critical to execute the Plan. In accordance with the guidance provided in the Plan, as revised, Reed should promptly notify Region V upon the occurrence of any of the following: identification of the leaking fuel element, significant revision to the Plan, or the occurrence of abnormal events. Furthermore, please note that prior to resuming routine operation, you are required by Technical Specification 4.E.4 to satisfy the conditions of Amendment No. 5 to Facility Operating License No. R-112, issued January 16, 1992, and to locate and remove from service any leaking fuel element.

. With this concurrence in the Plan, as revised, Reed has satisfied the conditions of the CAL.

In accordance with the requirements of 10 CFR 2.790, a copy of this letter will be placed in the NRC Public Document Room.
