The staff has completed its review of the request and finds that VYNPC's procedures, including documented commitments, are acceptable. The enclosed Safety Evaluation will be incorporated into the licensee's Offsite Dose Calculation Manual (ODCM) as an appendix.

Pursuant to the provisions of 10 CFR Part 51, the Commission has published in the <u>Federal Register</u> an Environmental Assessment and Finding of No Significant Impact (61 FR 8984).
