Dear Mr. Reid:

By letters dated November 18, 1991, and July 10, 1992, the Vermont Yankee Nuclear Power Corporation (VYNPC) submitted a request pursuant to 10 CFR Part 20, Subpart K, Section 2002, for approval of proposed procedures for disposing of slightly contaminated radioactive soil on site at the Vermont Yankee Nuclear Power Station. The staff has completed its review of the request and finds that VYNPC's procedures, including documented commitments, are acceptable. The enclosed Safety Evaluation will be incorporated into the licensee's Offsite Dose Calculation Manual (ODCM) as an appendix.

Pursuant to the provisions of 10 CFR Part 51, the Commission has published in the Federal Register an Environmental Assessment and Finding of No Significant Impact (61 FR 8984).
