Dear Ms. Gruszynski:

This letter is our notice that the City of Brookings SD, intends to terminate its license No. 40-19777-01 for possession and use of a Troxler Model 3411-B Nuclear Density Gauge. The costs being placed on continued licensing have made it economically unfeasible to maintain the ownership of the unit. A cost of \$1,500.00 plus cost of inspections is extraordinary considering there has been no cost to the city up to this time. Attached is the resolution declaring the gauge surplus and directing its sale.

I also must strongly protest the extremely limited time allowed between final rules issuance and the imposition of the fee. Indeed, the rules became effective in August of 1991, and we are being billed for the past year. That is very difficult to understand. We feel that your agency should extend the time allowed to terminate the ownership of this gauge. I know that nearly every other public agency feels the same by the amount of calls and complaints you have received. I am unable to even get my calls to the billing agency returned, and we are in "FINAL NOTICE".

May I please have the courtesy of a reply.

WHEREAS, the City of Brookings is the owner of the following described property:

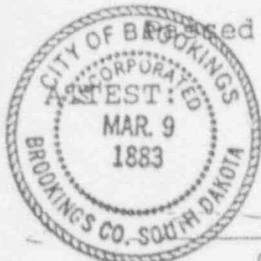
Troxler Model 3411B Moisture-Density Gauge with case and accessories (Serial #8157)


Appraised value \$499.00
