
This is in response to your letter of May 29, 1984, in which you requested, pursuant to the Freedom of Information Act, documents pertaining to the Pilgrim I Nuclear Power Station between 1976 and 1980.

Enclosed is a computer printout indicating the documents contained in Docket Number 50-293 (Pilgrim I). This list is run in document type order: letters, memoranda, and reports. The first page of the printout has been copied and annotated to assist you in your review of the documents contained in the docket file. Under availability, where CF is indicated, this means that the document has not as yet been reviewed for a releasability determination and would require that review should you decide to request any of the CF documents. The documents indicating PDR availability are publicly available in the NRC's Public Document Room which is located at 1717 H Street, NW, Washington, DC 20555. Many of the PDR documents are also located in the LPDR, for which you received a table of contents in our June 21, 1984 response letter.

If you should decide to request certain documents which are not available at the LPDR, you may obtain copies by writing directly to the PDR, indicating the accession numbers for each document. The charge for reproducing records located in the PDR is five cents (\$0.05) per page, as specified in 10 CFR 9.14(a). Upon your agreement to pay the reproduction charges, the PDR will arrange for the records to be reproduced by a private reproduction contractor servicing the PDR. You will be billed by the contractor for the reproduction charges, plus tax and postage.

This completes action on your request.
