SUBJECT: POSSIBLE MEDIA INTEREST IN TRANSFORMER EXPLOSION AND FIRE

The licensee declared an Unusual Event at 5:36 a.m. (EST) on December 15 after an explosion and fire in a B phase transformer for a 500-KV line occurred at 4:26 a.m. (EST). Prompt response from the plant fire brigade resulted in the fire being completely extinguished within eight minutes. The Unusual Event was cancelled at 5:39 a.m. (EST).

There were no injuries and no damage to safety-related equipment. Preliminary review indicates that the transformer exploded, possibly as the result of an internal short.

Unit 1 was operating at 100 percent power, and Unit 2 was in the process of heating up for restart following a refueling outage. Operation of each Unit proceeded without interruption. Although Unit 1 was supplying the 500-KV bus, the loss of load did not affect generator output.

The resident inspectors are following the licensee's evaluation and corrective action.

Local media interest is expected because TVA is placing an announcement of the event on its automated media call-in telephones.

The State of Tennessee has been informed.

The NRC received initial notification of this event by telephone from the licensee to the Incident Response Center at 4:47 a.m. (EST) on December 17.
