1SSUANCE OF AMENDMENT NO. 11 TO AMENDED FACILITY LICENSE NO. DPR-4 - SAXTON NUCLEAR EXPERIMENTAL CORPORATION

(TAC NO. M76768)

The Commission has issued the enclosed Amendment No. 11 to Amended Facility License No. DPR-4 for the Saxton Nuclear Experimental Corporation. The amendment consists of changes to the Technical Specifications in response to your submittal dated September 22, 1987, as supplemented on February 25, 1988, April 27, 1988, April 26, 1990, September 6, 1990, January 31, 1991 July 16, 1991, March 3, 1992, March 6, 1992, and April 2, 1992.

The amendment revises the description of the facility site by removing the Control and Auxiliary Building, the Radioactive Waste Disposal Facility, the Refueling Water Storage Tank, the Filled Drum Storage Area, and the Pipe Tunnel (the outbuildings) from the license. The amendment also makes editorial change of the license, updates the reporting requirements for the facility, and changes the method for water analysis for radionuclides.

Please note that our review does not include Appendix F, "Environmental Pathways Analysis" of the "Final Release Survey of the Reactor Support Ruildings." The question of environmental pathways analysis for the Saxton site will be addressed at the time of the containment decommissioning and termination of the facility license.

After work to remove the outbuildings is complete, please submit a report to NRC that summarizes the removal process and the results of surveys taken during the work.
