Dear Mr. Congel:

Enclosed is a copy of the final exercise report for the February 11, 1992, unannounced/off-hours partial-participation exercise of the offsite radiological emergency response plans site-specific to the Callaway Nuclear Power Plant emergency planning zone. The State of Missouri partially participated in the exercise and the Counties of Callaway, Gasconade, Montgomery, and Osage fully participated. This report, dated May 8, 1992, was prepared by the Region VII staff of the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA). A copy of the enclosed report will be provided to the State of Missouri.

There were no Deficiencies identified during the February 11, 1992, exercise. There were, however, six Areas Requiring Corrective Action (ARCA) identified. These ARCA's will be corrected on or before the next scheduled biennial exercise.

Based on the results of the February 11, 1992, exercise, the State of Missouri and local radiological emergency response plans and preparedness site-specific to the Callaway Nuclear Power Plant are adequate to provide reasonable assurance that appropriate measures can be taken offsite to protect the health and safety of the public in the event of a radiological emergency at the site. Therefore, the Title 44 CFR, Part 350 approval of the State of Missouri and local radiological emergency response plans and preparedness site-specific to the Callaway Nuclear Power Plant, granted on July 9, 1985, remains in effect.
