Gentlemen:

This is to acknowledge receipt of your letter dated May 21, 1992, transmitting the objectives for the upcoming emergency preparedness exercise. The objectives have been evaluated by our staff using NRC Inspection Procedure 82302. The specific objectives appear reasonable and meet the guidance of NUREG 0654.

On June 10, 1992, our comments regarding the objectives were discussed in a telephone conversation between Dr. D. Blair Spitzberg of our staff and Mr. Mark Schreiber of your organization. The comments concerned your development of specific evaluation criteria for each objective and ensuring that areas of previous exercise weakness will be redemonstrated during the exercise. Redemonstration of previous weak areas should present similar challenges to those which existed when the weaknesses were identified.

We understand from our telephone discussion that the exercise scenario will address these items. Please submit your scenario and associated materials to the NRC for review at least 65 days prior to the exercise.

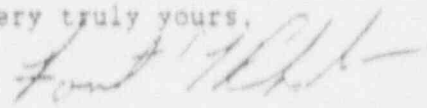
