In Section 3.11.4.1.2 of SSER No. 6, the staff reported that as a confirmatory issue, the applicant must submit analyses for the nitrogen (N-16) detector and N-16 junction box to confirm that this equipment has been environmentally qualified. This information was presented in Amendment 53 of the Comanche Peak FSAR. The staff finds that the information presented in FSAR Amendment 53 is sufficient to close out the subject issue. This will be accomplished in the next SER supplement.
