ORDER TERMINATING FURTHER PROCEEDINGS ON REMAND ISSUES

By letter to the Board dated December 11, 1984, Suffolk County informed us that it does not wish to pursue through litigation the issue involving Unresolved Safety Issue A-47 (control systems interactions) which was remanded by the Appeal Board. ALAB-788, 20 NRC _____ (October 31, 1984). As may be readily inferred from our "Order Confirming Rulings on Remand Issues" (unpublished) (November 20, 1984), and our "Memorandum and Order Ruling on Remand Issues," LPP-84-53, 20 NRC ____ (November 30, 1984), we find no substantive or procedural basis to pursue the remanded issues <u>sua sponte</u>.

Therefore, in light of Suffolk County's letter and this Licensing Board's orders cited above, this proceeding is terminated with respect to the issues remanded by ALAB-788.
