The NRC staff has reviewed the Wolf Creek Nuclear Operating Corporation submittals of February 2, 1996, and February 23, 1996, requesting approval to use, as appropriate, one of the three proposed alternatives in lieu of performing the Code required 10-year hydrostatic test for certain Class 1 and 2 systems.

Use of the proposed alternatives in conjunction with the clarifications and provisions as noted in the safety evaluation is authorized for the duration of the currently approved inservice inspection program interval, pursuant to 10 CFR 50.55a(a)(3)(ii), in that compliance with the requirements would result in hardship or unusual difficulty without a compensating increase in the level of quality and safety. The staff's evaluation and conclusions are contained in the enclosed safety evaluation.
