NOTIFICATION OF UNUSUAL EVENT

On June 18, 1992 at approximately 1700 with the reactor defueled, an employee was injured while working in the drywell. He had been working in a contaminated area, but a complete survey of the individual for contamination was not possible prior to his transport to Our Lady of the Lake Hospital, in Baton Rouge, Louisiana for medical attention.

At 1747, a Notification of Unusual Event (NOUE) was declared per Emergency Implementing Procedure EIP-2-001, Emergency Action Level 17, "Transportation of overexposed or contaminated injured individual from site to hospital" when the individual was transported to the hospital. The NOUE was subsequently terminated at 1925 when the individual and his clothing was surveyed and determined to not be contaminated.

Initial notification to the State of Louisiana and State of Mississippi, the five local governments within the 10 mile Emergency Planning Zone and the Nuclear Regulatory Commission Incident Response Center of the declaration began at approximately 1756. Notification to the state and local governments and NRC of the termination began at 1935 after it was reported that neither the individual nor his clothing was contaminated.
