SUBJECT: UNSCHEDULED SHUTDOWN GREATER THAN 48 HOURS

St. Lucie Unit 2 is expected to be out of service for about five days for replacement of a reactor coolant pump seal. The seal failed yesterday when a turbine trip and reactor trip occurred due to low condenser vacuum, which resulted from a leak in a condensate pump recirculation line.

The transient, which aggravated an earlier indentified reactor coolant pump seal deficiency, occurred as the unit was at 60 percent power and was increasing power.

The State of Florida has been informed.

The licensee informed the NRC headquarters incident response center of this occurrence at 1:35 p.m. (EST) yesterday. This information is current as of 8 a.m. today.
