Houston Lighting & Power Company (HL&P) submits this letter to revise the above referenced response to NRC Generic Letter 89-13 for South Texas Project Units 1 and 2. Under Recommended Action I of the Generic Letter, HL&P was to implement and maintain an ongoing program of surveillance and control techniques to significantly reduce the incidence of flow blockage problems as a result of biofouling of the Essential Cooling Water System (ECW). Included in the response was a statement that "scaling and corrosion inhibitors are also added to the ECW." HL&P considers the addition of corrosion inhibitors to the ECW system an option and has discontinued this treatment.

One of corrosion inhibitors was discontinued because operational experience has shown that the corrosion rate without inhibitors has no impact on the design life of the ECW system. Without the inhibitors, the corrosion rate is 0.6 mil/year compared to <0.1 mil/year with the inhibitor. Assuming 40 years of service life, this will not result in corrosion exceeding the design level of 40 mils.
