NOTICE OF VIOLATION

South Carolina Electric and Gas Company V. C. Summer

Docket No. 50-395 License No. NPF-12

The following violation was identified during an inspection conducted on August 27-31, 1984. The Severity Level was assigned in accordance with the NRC Enforcement Policy (10 CFR Part 2, Appendix C).

Technical Specification 6.11 requires that Radiation Protection Procedures be written and adhered to. Licensee procedure HPP-401, Issue, Termination, and Use of RWPs, requires that workers comply with the requirements stated in the RWP. Radiation Work Permit 08-36, issued August 28, 1984, for decontamination of a floor area on the 374 ft. elevation of the Auxiliary Building, specified that protective clothing be worn, including a surgeon's cap.

Contrary to the above, on August 29, 1984, the inspector observed that the requirement of the RWP to wear a surgeon's cap was not being met in that one worker performing the decontamination work was not wearing a surgeon's cap.

This is a Severity Level IV violation (Supplement IV).

Pursuant to 10 CFR 2.201, you are required to submit to this office within 30 days of the date of this Notice, a written statement or explanation in reply, including: (1) admission or denial of the alleged violation; (2) the reasons for the violation if admitted; (3) the corrective steps which have been taken and the results achieved; (4) corrective steps which will be taken to avoid further violations; and (5) the date when full compliance will be achieved.

Security or safeguards information should be submitted as an enclosure to facilitate withholding it from public disclosure as required by 10 CFR 2.790(d) or 10 CFR 73.21.
