## NOTICE OF VIOLATION

Virginia Electric and Power Company North Anna Unit 1 and 2 Docket No. 50-338 and 50-339 License No. NPF-4 and NPF-7

During an NRC inspection conducted on April 19 - May 16, 1992, a violation of """ requirements was identified. In accordance with the "General Statement olicy and Procedure for NRC Enforcement Actions, 10 CFR Part 2, Appendix 1991), the violation is listed below:

Technical Specification Table 6.2-1 requires that procedures will be established to indure that NRC policy statement guided has regarding working hours established for employees are followed.

Seneric Letter 82-12. Nuclear Power Plant Staff Working Hours, establishes NRC policy statement guidelines on overtime limits, one of which is 72 hours in any seven day period and that deviation from the guidelines may be authorized under very unusual circumstances.

Contrary to the above, VPAP-0103, Working Hours and Limitations, failed to adequately insure that the NRC policy statement guidelines were followed in that personnel routinely, and on a widespread basis, exceeded 72 hours in seven (ay periods for conducting outage activities and maintaining emergency plan standby coverage.

This everity Level IV violation (Supplement I).

Pursuant to the provisions of 10 CFK 2.201, Virginia Elect ic and Power Company is hereby required to submit a written statement or explanation to the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission, ATTN: Document Control Desk, Washington, D.C. 20555 with a copy to the Regional Administrator, Region II, a copy to the NRC Resident Inspector at the facility that is the subject of this Notice, within 30 days of the date of the letter transmitting this Notice of Violation (Notice). This reply should be clearly marked as a "Reply to a Notice of Violation" and should include for each violation: (1) the reason for the violation, or, if contested, the basis for disputing the violation, (2) the corrective steps that have been taken and the results achieved, (3) the date when full compliance will be achieved. If an usequate ruply is not received within the time specified in this Notice, an order or demand for Virginia Electric and Power -2- Docket Nos. 50-338 and 50-339 Company North Anna Unit 1 and 2

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information may be issued as to why the license should not be modified, suspended, or revoked, or why such other action as may be proper should not be taken. Where good cause is shown, sideration will be given to extending the response time.
