SUBJECT: ALLEGATION RI-93-A-0013 CLOSURE

This allegation was an anonymous input stating that a security guard did not make a required two-hour tour of a vital area and that this was not reported to the NRC.

The allegation was reviewed during Oyster Creek Inspection 50-219/93-26 (copy attached). In Report Detail 5.0, the conclusion that the vital area patrols exceeded the minimum required by the plan was documented as a positive licensee initiative.

Inasmuch as 10CFR73.21(b)(1)(iv) identifies written physical security orders and procedures for members of the security organization and patrol schedules as protected Safeguards Information, it is not appropriate to identify and/or confirm the required and/or actual patrol schedules in non-safeguards documents. The inspector found, however, that the alleged failure would not result in violating the NRC-approved security plan for this facility and is not required to be reported to the NRC. Therefore, no unacceptable condition was alleged.

Based on the above, closure of this allegation is recommended.
