SUBJECT: CLOSEOUT OF ALLEGATION RI-93-A-0134 AT THE  
OYSTER CREEK NUCLEAR GENERATING STATION

On June 25, 1993, the NRC received an anonymous allegation regarding an individual who was asked to install shielding on recirculation pumps in the drywell during 14R at the Oyster Creek Nuclear Generating Station without using a respirator. Apparently, the radiation control supervisor briefly explained the concept of trying to reduce dose by not using respirators, but actions taken during the job were not always prudent and were not well explained. Additionally, the allegor stated that he has worked at Oyster Creek during outages for the last 10 years, and that he has never installed shielding on recirculation pumps in the Oyster Creek drywell without using a respirator.

As a result, allegation panels were convened on June 30, 1993, and September 22, 1993, and the NRC decided to review these issues during an upcoming DRSS inspection to resolve the allegation.

The NRC has found this allegation to be resolved based on the enclosed NRC Inspection Report No. 50-219/93-18 dated November 1, 1993, that was conducted by DRSS on August 23-27, 1993.

Based on the anonymous nature of the allegation, no response to the allegor is appropriate. Actions are considered complete for allegation RI-93-A-0134. This allegation is closed.
