The NRC has completed its inspection into an anonymous allegation where an individual was concerned that the recent wash out of the Route 9 bridge, just north of the Oyster Creek Nuclear Generating Station, would affect the site emergency evacuation plan. The individual also expressed a concern that the NRC should expedite the State's repair to the bridge.

We found this allegation unsubstantiated. Based on a review of the applicable portions of the Oyster Creek emergency plan by the resident inspectors, documented in Inspection Report 50-219/91-22 (applicable portions attached), and recent NRC emergency preparedness inspections in this area, we have concluded that evacuation was still possible with the Route 9 bridge washed out. As for the individual's request that the NRC should expedite the State's repairs to the bridge, coordination between the NRC and State is defined in the NRC emergency operations plan and provides the basis for dialogue for public evacuation. The NRC has no authority to direct bridge repair.

Allegation RI-91-A-0195 is closed.
