

In a letter dated September 28, 1984, Gulf States Utilities Company (GSU) responded to Bulletin 83-07 "Apparently Fraudulent Products Sold by Ray Miller, Inc." with the information available at that time and committed to provide a final response or status report by November 26, 1984.

GSU's investigation has determined that no defective material or equipment manufactured by Ray Miller, Inc. has been procured for use at River Bend Station in nonsafety-related systems by its vendors (the architect/engineer, Stone & Webster Engineering Corporation and NSSS supplier, the General Electric Company) or through their subsuppliers as identified in I&E Bulletin 83-07 and Supplements 1 & 2.
