SUBJECT: MEDIA INTEREST IN MINOR PERSONNEL CONTAMINATION

At about midnight on the morning of Sunday, December 16, 1984, three workers received minor radioactive contamination of their clothing and skin while investigating a malfunctioning security card reader. As a result of this incident, the licensee issued a letter to all personnel encouraging good radiation protection practices. The incident was reported by the local news media and has since been picked up by UPI wire service and CBS news. As a result, Region V has been responding to numerous news inquiries.

The incident was of inconsequential radiological significance and this PN is being issued because of widespread media publicity.

The licensee and Region V will continue to respond to inquiries.
