Subject: Update of Staff's Evaluation of Comanche Peak Steam Electric Station Compliance with TMI Action Plan Item I.C.1, "Guidance for the Evaluation and Development of Procedures for Transients and Accidents"

In Section 22 of Comanche Peak SER Supplement No. 6, the staff described its review of the Comanche Peak Procedures Generation Package (PGP). As a part of that review, the staff stated that deviations from approved technical guidelines must be reviewed and approved prior to initial criticality of Comanche Peak, Unit 1.

The staff has reviewed the deviations from Revision 1 of the Westinghouse Owners Group Emergency Response Guidelines (ERGs) identified in TUGCO's letter dated August 24, 1984 (H. C. Schmidt to B. J. Youngblood), and finds Revision 1 acceptable for implementation. The staff's acceptance was documented in a letter to Westinghouse (D. G. Eisenhut to J. J. Sheppard) dated December 27, 1984. On the basis of this action, the deviations TUGCO identified in TUGCO's August 24, 1984 letter to the then-approved plant-specific technical guidelines are acceptable for full power operation of Comanche Peak, Unit 1. However, please be advised that future modification to the Comanche Peak plant-specific technical guidelines and emergency operating procedures may be necessary based on a more detailed review of Revision 1 to the Westinghouse Owners Group ERGs.

Completion of the description of the program for conducting the function and task analysis, as described in SER Supplement No. 6, remains a condition to the license, and is to be resolved prior to startup following the first refueling outage of Unit 1.

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We propose to document this evaluation update in a future Comanche Peak SER supplement. If there are any questions, your staff should direct them to the Licensing Project Manager.

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
