Subject: Revision of Completion Dates for Corrective Actions

In voluntary Licensee Event Report (LER) 91-08, *Inappropriate Surveillance Requirements for RPS Level 1 Bistables*, Omaha Public Power District (OPPD) committed to a series of corrective actions. Included was that each surveillance procedure would be reviewed by July 1, 1992 to verify it adequately meets the intent of the Technical Specifications. The first phase of this verification, to assure all applicable Technical Specifications have corresponding surveillance procedures, has been completed. However, due to underestimation of the time to complete supporting tasks, OPPD needs to revise the completion date for this item to November 20, 1992.

In LER 91-11, *Pressurizer Pressure Low Signal (PPLS) Setpoints*, OPPD committed to implement by June 1992 a program to evaluate similar safety significant instrument loops and setpoints. The portion of this program which includes detailed analysis of the RPS or ESF trip functions is complete, except for the Thermal Margin/Low Power (TM/LP) trip function. This analysis is incomplete due to the unanticipated need for vendor support in evaluating the design basis setpoint calculations. Therefore, the completion date for program implementation needs to be revised to December 31, 1992.

Mr. P. H. Harwell of the NRC Region IV staff concurred with the revised completion dates noted above during a telephone call from Mr. R. W. Short of my staff on July 1, 1992.
