AFFIDAVIT OF DENNIS J. KUPICKI IN SUPPORT OF NRC STAFF'S MOTION TO PEOPEN THE PECORD TO CORRECT STAFF TESTIMONY

I Dennis J. Kubicki, being duly sworn do depose and state:

- My name is Dennis J. Kubicki. I am employed as a Fire Protection
 Engineer in the Chemical Engineering Branch, Division of Engineering,
 Office of Nuclear Reactor Regulation. A copy of my professional
 cualifications has previously been admitted into this record as part
 of NRC Staff Exhibit 8.
- On December 17, 1984, I testified in this proceeding as an NRC Staff witness, during a conference call on Eddleman Contention 116,
 Fire Protection.
- 3. As a result of my review of the transcript of that conference call and my reexamination of Applicants' documents concerning the special purpose doors which were the subject of my testimony, I have determined that there are two corrections which are necessary to my testimony of December 17, 1984.

- First, at Tr. 7429 in response to a question by the Board Chairman. 4. I agreed that the special purpose doors are made of solid steel plates. In fact, some of the doors are so constructed. However, a number of the doors are constructed of two plates of steel of different thickness so as to form a hollow core. The maximum resulting air gap is eight inches. This correction has no effect on the conclusions reached in NRC Staff Exhibit 8 or upon the rest of my testimony in this proceeding.
- 5. Second, in response to another Board question concerning the location of the locking mins all around the edges of these doors, I responded that to my knowledge, the locking pins were present in that configuration. Tr. 7431. In fact, some of the doors have horizontal latching bolts and some have vertical latching bolts. None of the doors have them in both directions. This correction has no effect on either the conclusions reached in NRC Staff Exhibit 8 or on my testimony in this proceeding.
