## ORDER

Intervenor Sunflower Alliance, Inc. (Sunflower) has noted an appeal from the Licensing Board's January 10, 1985 memorandum and order (unpublished) in this operating license proceeding<sup>1</sup>, as amended in a January 14, 1985 erratum. Because it appears that all of the rulings contained in the memorandum and order are wholly interlocutory in character, Sunflower is directed to show cause <u>no later than Friday,</u> <u>February 15, 1985</u> why its appeal should not be dismissed. See 10 CFR 2.730(f); <u>Puget Sound Power and Light Co.</u> (Skagit/Hanford Nuclear Power Project, Units 1 and 2), ALAB-712, 17 NRC 81, 82 (1983), and cases there cited. Upon
