ORDER

Oral argument on the appeal of Suffolk County and the State of New York from the Licensing Board's October 29, 1984 initial decision<sup>1</sup> will be held at 2:00 p.m. on Monday, February 11, 1985, in the NRC Public Hearing Room, Fifth Floor, East-West Towers Building, 4350 East-West Highway, Bethesda, Maryland.<sup>2</sup> Each side is allotted a total of one hour for the presentation of argument.<sup>3</sup> The appellants will


be heard first and may reserve a reasonable portion of their time for rebuttal.
