This refers to the inspection conducted by Mr. T. W. Dexter of this office on June 15-19, 1992. The inspection included a review of activities authorized for your South Texas Project facility. At the conclusion of the inspection, the findings were discussed with Mr. W. H. Kinsey and those members of your staff identified in the enclosed report.

The inspection involed the review of certain areas of your physical security program. Areas examined during the inspection are identified in the report. Within these areas, the inspection consisted of selective examinations of procedures and representative records, interviews with personnel, and observations by the inspector.

Based on the results of this inspection, certain of your activities appeared to be in violation of NRC requirements, as specified in the enclosed Notice of Violation (Notice). The violation is of concern because it involved the failure to properly protect safeguards information during transmittal to other departments and/or agencies.

You are required to respond to this letter and should follow the instructions specified in the enclosed Notice when preparing your response. In your response, you should document the specific actions taken and any additional
