I. SECY-92-230 - Motion to Modify or Quash Subpoenas by Houston Lighting and Power Company, et al. (South Texas Project, Units 1 and 2)

The Commission, by a 4-6 vote, approved an order responding to a motion to modify or quash subpoenas issued by the NRC's Director of the Office of Investigations in conjunction with an investigation into the denial of access of Thomas J. Saporito, Gr. to the South Texas Project. The Order denied the motion to modify or quash the subpoenas in this case. Chairman Selin was unavailable to participate in this matter.

(Subsequently, the Secretary signed the Order on July 2, 1992.)

II. COMSECY-92-017 - Safety Light Corporation - Licensing Board Order Consolidating Proceedings on License Denials and on Decontamination Order

The Commission, by a 5-0 vote,* approved an order responding to a June 11, 1992 Licensing Board consolidation order and a June 26, 1992 staff petition for review of the order. The order requests the parties in this proceeding to address a number of questions in writing by July 13, 1992, with replies to the initial submittals by July 20, 1992. The Licensing Board and Presiding Officer in the proceeding are also invited to provide views in this matter by July 24, 1992.

^{*} Section 201 of the Energy Reorganization Act, 42 U.S.C. §5841, provides that action of the Commission shall be determined by a "majority vote of the members present." Chairman Selin was not present when this item was affirmed. Accordingly the formal vote of the Commission was 4-0 in favor of the decision. Chairman Selin, however, had previously indicated that he would approve this paper and had he been present he would have affirmed his prior vote.
