Subject: Systematic Assessment of Licensee Performance (SALP); Reports No. 50-286/84-18 and 50-333/84-17

This refers to the evaluations we have conducted for the two nuclear facilities operated by the Power Authority. Although the two evaluations were conducted separately, there are common indicators of aggressive and effective corporate management involvement. Both reports were discussed in two meetings that were held on September 13, 1984 at the James A. Fitzpatrick facility in Scriba, New York. Your written comments relative to our reports have been reviewed and are enclosed. Some changes in the SALP reports have been made to reflect the additional information provided and these are noted in the enclosed SALP reports.

The SALP for Indian Point 3 Nuclear Power Plant was conducted by this office on August 14, 1984, and discussed on September 13, 1984.

Our overall assessment of your facility operation concludes that there is effective management attention, oriented toward nuclear safety, in all functional areas evaluated. The maintaining of a Category I assessment in nine of the eleven functional areas reflects your commitment to sustain a high level of performance. It is also noteworthy that improvement has been realized in Licensing Activities.

The SALP for J. A. FitzPatrick Nuclear Power Plant was conducted by this office on August 13, 1984. Our overall assessment of the Fitzpatrick facility concludes that there is an acceptable level of management attention and involvement in all functional areas. It was noted that a high level of performance has been maintained in Security and Safeguards and improving trends in three other categories were demonstrated while management attention is warranted in the surveillance area. Overall we continue to note improvements at the facility reflecting an aggressive management involvement toward improving all aspects of facility operation.

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In your letter of October 10, 1984, you requested that we re-evaluate the findings of Category 2 in the area of Emergency Preparedness at the J.A. FitzPatrick Nuclear Power Plant. Based on our discussions at the September management meeting and information provided in your October 10 letter, the SALP Board found it appropriate to revise the rating for the Emergency Preparedness area from Category 2 to Category 1.

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No reply to this letter is required. Your actions in response to the NRC Systematic Assessment of Licensee Performance will be reviewed during future inspections of your licensed activities.

Your cooperation with us is appreciated.
