SUBJECT: NOTICE OF VIOLATION (NRC INSPECTION REPORT NOS. 50-321/92-11 AND 50-365/92-11)

This refers to the inspection conducted by W. J. Tobin of this office on April 27 - May 1, 1992. The inspection included a review of activities authorized for your Plant Hatch tacility. At the conclusion of the inspection, the findings were discussed with those membars of your staff identified in the report.

Areas examined during the inspection are identified in the report. Within these areas, the inspection consisted of selective examinations of procedures and representative records, interviews with personnel, and observation of activities in progress.

Based on the results of this inspection, certain of your activities appeared to be in violation of NPC requirements, as specified in the enclosed Notice of Violation (Notice). The violations are of concern because they reflect a lack of regulatory sensitivity to NRC requirements and Security Plan commitments. During this inspection we noted improvements with the completion of your Security Equipment Upgrade. In addition, the enclosed Inspection Report identifies activities that violated NRC requirements that will not be subject to enforcement action because the licensea's efforts in identifying and/or correcting the violation meet the criteria specified in Section VII.B. of the Enforcement Policy.

The material enclosed herewith contains Safeguards Information as defined by 10 CFR Part 73.21 and its disclosure to unauthorized individuals is prohibited by Section 147 of the Atomic Energy Act of 1954, as amended. Therefore, the material will not be placed in the Public Document From.
