**SUBJECT: FINAL SEABROOK SYSTEMATIC ASSESSMENT OF LICENSEE  
PERFORMANCE (SALP) REPORT FOR THE PERIOD FROM  
NOVEMBER 1, 1990 TO FEBRUARY 29, 1992 (50-443/90-99)**

This forwards the Final Seabrook Nuclear Power Plant SALP Report (Enclosure 1). The assessment found careful, conservative planning and safe, proficient accomplishment of activities. A superior level of performance was achieved in the areas of Emergency Preparedness and Security. A good level of performance was attained in the other areas assessed. In the areas of Maintenance/Surveillance, Engineering/Technical Support, and Safety Assessment/Quality Verification, an improving trend was noted.

We note that the comments presented at our June 8, 1992 meeting and your June 24, 1992 letter (Enclosure 2) constructively addressed areas for clarifying specific sections of the SALP report. A list of attendees and NRC slides from the June 8, 1992 meeting are attached (Enclosure 3). We appreciate you sharing your plans for continued improvement in Seabrook's performance.

The enclosed Final SALP Report differs from the SALP Board Report forwarded to you on May 21, 1992 (Enclosure 4) only in minor corrections which did not result in changes to any of the SALP ratings.

No reply to this letter is required. Thank you for your cooperation.
