Dear Mr. Orser:

This refers to the inspection conducted by S. Stasek, K. Riemer, T. Tongue, T. Triburn, R. Stransky and D. Roth of this office on May 8 to June 30, 1992. The inspection included a review of authorized activities for your Fermi 2 facility. At the conclusion of the inspection, the findings were discussed with those members of your staff identified in the enclosed report.

Areas examined during the inspection are identified in the report. Within these areas, the inspection consisted of a selective examination of procedures and representative records, observations, and interviews with personnel.

During this inspection, certain of your activities appeared to be in violation of NRC requirements. However, as described in the enclosed inspection report, you identified these violations. Therefore, the violations will not be subject to enforcement action because your efforts in identifying and correcting the violations meet the criteria specified in Section VII.B of the "General Statement of Policy and Procedures for NRC Enforcement Actions," (Enforcement Policy, 10 CFR Part 2, Appendix C 1992).

In accordance with 10 CFR 2.790 of the Commission's regulations, a copy of this letter and the enclosed inspection report will be placed in the NRC Public Document Room.
