This is to notify you that all fuel possessed under the referenced license has been shipped from the facility.


The preparation and shipment of all of the full length fuel rods was conducted pursuant to the license. The preparation, including the cutting of fuel rods, of damaged or partial rods was performed in accordance with the license and amendment No. 13.

The full length rods were shipped to the DOE facility at Oak Ridge, Tennessee. Partial and damaged rod sections and residues from the cutting operation were sent to Nation Lead Co. Cincinnati, Ohio.

I therefore requested that the Lynchburg Research Center be granted authorization to proceed with the dismantling and decontamination of the facility in accordance with our applications dated, August 7, 1984 and November 15, 1984.
