Dear Mr. Liu:

On May 26, 1992, we received Revision 13 to the Duane Arnold Energy Center's Emergency Plan. We have reviewed Revision 13 and have determined that it is acceptable and that it does not degrade the effectiveness of your emergency planning.

Revision 13 included refinements to a number of the emergency action levels utilized to classify emergency conditions. Some of these refinements were based on changes to control room instrumentation. The plan revision included descriptions of the upgraded organization of supervisory personnel assigned to the Operational Support Center. Several changes to the Technical Support Center's organization were described in Revision 13. The revision included clarifications regarding: training requirements for emergency responders; criteria for considering certain response facilities to be adequately staffed; and the types of environmental samples that can be analyzed at an offsite response facility. Revision 13 also contained a number of minor editorial changes.
