SUBJECT: NRC INSPECTION NOS. 50-313/92-19; 50-368/92-19

This refers to the team inspection conducted by Mr. Nemen M. Terc of this office and other accompanying personnel during the period June 23-26, 1992, of activities authorized for your Arkansas Nuclear One.

At the conclusion of the inspection, the findings were discussed with you and those members of your staff identified in the enclosed report.

Areas examined during the inspection included the implementation of your emergency plan and procedures during your annual emergency response exercise. Within these areas, the inspection consisted of selective examination of procedures and representative records, interviews with personnel, and observations by the inspectors. The inspection findings are documented in the enclosed inspection report.

Within the scope of the inspection, no violations or deviations were identified.

Your staff's participation in the emergency exercise demonstrated that your emergency preparedness program and staff were prepared to protect the health and safety of the public. However, the enclosed inspection report identifies three areas of weakness in your emergency preparedness program. Weaknesses involved: discrepancies in the notification process, inadequate briefing of the NRC response team, and inadequate radiological control measures to protect field survey teams.

Exercise weaknesses according to 10 CFR Part 50, Appendix E.IV.F.5, are inspection findings that need to be corrected by the licensee. You are requested to provide this office with a description of your corrective measures and your schedule for completing these actions within 30 days after receipt of this letter.
