## ORDER DIRECTING PARTIES TO CONFER AND TO FILE CROSS-EXAMINATION PLANS

The parties are directed to confer for the purpose of attempting to settle or at least narrow the issues remaining in controversy in this emergency diesel generator phase of the hearing. The parties shall file a joint report which summarizes the result of the discussions. The report shall include a precise specification of which sub-issues remain in controversy, and why, in the <u>seriatim</u> categories of: (1) the proposed qualified load of 3300 kw, (2) the cylinder block and (3) the crankshaft. The report shall be received by the Board by February 8, 1985. Th: Board plans to begin the February 12 hearing with a discussion of this joint report.
