Gentlemen:

As required by Reference (a), this letter reports the number of tubes plugged in the Calvert Cliffs Unit 1 Steam Generators during the recently completed Inservice Inspection.

Based on recent Eddy Current Examination results of the Unit 1 Steam Generators, we plugge 1 11 tubes in Steam Generator No. 11 and 7 tubes in Steam Generator No. 12. In addition, a tube (R-93,L-67) in Steam Generator No. 12, which had been erroneously plugged on the cold leg side in 1986 (LER 317/88-03), was plugged on the hot leg side. The total number of tubes plugged in Steam Generator Nos. 11 and 12 are 118 and 77, respectively.
