Subject: Vogtle - Eligibility of Archeological Sites for National Register
of Historic Places

Pursuant to our responsibility under 36 CFR 63 as licensing agency for the operation of Vogtle, Units 1 and 2, the NRC requests information necessary to initiate a determination of eligibility request to the Keeper of the National Register. The information requested is in regard to the three sites you identified in the Vogtle to Wadley transmission line cultural resource survey report as being potentially eligible for inclusion in the National Register of Historic Places.

The U.S. Department of Interior form (FHR8-300) entitled "National Register of Historic Places Inventory-Nomination Form" (enclosed) may be used and should be filled out in detail with appropriate maps and other materials for each of the three sites and returned to the NRC. Item 12 of the form does not need to be completed. You may wish to refer to the Federal Register, September 21, 1977, Part II for detailed guidance with regard to the level of documentation necessary to accompany the requested information. The NRC requests that you take appropriate measures to protect the resources during the determination of eligibility process.

The reporting and/or recordkeeping requirements contained in this letter affect fewer than ten respondents; therefore, OMB clearance is not required under P.L. 96-511.
