This is in response to your letter of June 15, 1984, in which you requested, pursuant to the Freedom of Information Act, copies of documents received in response to the May 25, 1984 request from Darrell G. Eisenhut for additional information from Consumers Power Company regarding the structural adequacy of the Midland Diesel Generator Building.
