Dear Mr. Hanauer:

This is in response to your letter dated July 16, 1984, in which you requested, pursuant to the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA), all documents that set forth the case or other assignments of the three members of the Atomic Safety and Licensing Board that conducted the hearing regarding the Operating License for San Onofre 2/3, Docket numbers 50-361 and 50-362, during the period June 1, 1981, through January 11, 1982. You also requested all documents containing projections made by the ASLBP or ASLB or related organizations of the date foreseen for issuance of an Initial Decision for low power operation of San Onofre, Unit 2.

This confirms Mr. Frank W. Karas' telephone conversation with you on August 22, 1934, in which he informed you that the staff's search efforts have not turned up any documents subject to your request that have not already been made available for public inspection and copying in the NRC Public Counent Room (PDR) located at 1717 H Street, NW, Washington, DC.

With regard to the first part of your request, the staff noted that there is no one document which contains the subject information. To set forth such information, it would be necessary to combine information from many different documents and make a determination by a "process of elimination". The FOIA does not require an agency to create a new document to respond to a FOIA request.

There are no separate notices terminating members of a board. That matter is contained, when spoken to, in the notice reconstituting a board. By researching the notices reconstituting the boards (all are available in the PDR), you could develop a list showing each member's terminations from certain boards.
