SUBJECT: RESPONSE TO GENERIC LETTER 84-12 (LICENSING ACTION TAC 56562)

By letter dated December 13, 1984 you submitted your response to the subject letter by providing your Process Control Program (PCP) for the Beaver Valley Power Station, Unit No. 1, delineating the waste solidification process. We find that this PCP generally complies with current NRC criteria and therefore is acceptable on an interim basis for use with the Beaver Valley Technical Specification 3.11.3.1. The acceptability of this PCP is based on currently available guidelines, but a future revision should address compliance with 10 CFR 61, when revised guidance becomes available from the NRC.
