DAILY HIGHLIGHT - MEETING WITH GPU CONCERNING

THE TMI-1 EMERGENCY FEEDWATER SYSTEM

A meeting is scheduled with GPU Nuclear to provide an opportunity for GPU Nuclear to present the capabilities and limitations of the TMI-1 emergency feedwater (EFW) system with respect to the Union of Concerned Scientists (UCS) 2.206 petition. The intent of the meeting is to ensure that the staff has a full understanding of the technical aspects of the GPU Nuclear responses to the UCS petition. The meeting will be held at 11:00 a.m., Friday, April 27, 1984 in room P-114 of the Phillips Building. The meeting will be transcribed. As a follow-up action, G. Lainas, L. Rubenstein and F. Rowsome will visit the TMI-1 site on Monday, April 30 to walkdown the EFW system and look at other intermediate building systems.

By letter dated April 19, 1984 the staff also proposed a meeting with UCS. The purpose of the UCS meeting would similarly be to ensure the staff has a full understanding of the technical aspects of the UCS petition. A UCS response to the proposed meeting is pending.
