The licensee began withdrawing rods for initial criticality at 5:42 p.m. (CST) on February 1, 1985. Initial criticality was achieved at 11:23 p.m. on February 2, 1985. Acceptable agreement was observed between actual conditions at criticality and predicted conditions. Testing at power levels not to exceed 5 per cent of full power is underway and is expected to be completed by February 14, 1985. The entire startup test program is scheduled to be completed by June 1985.

In preparation for initial criticality, Region III (Chicago) manned the site on a continuous basis beginning January 31, 1985. The resident inspector was in the Control Room at the time criticality was achieved.
