I have registered my concerns thru petitions before but feel a need to write personally to implore you to consider the very serious hazard Limerick poses for the nearby residents. While safeguards against seem intensive, there is truly no safeguard against human error and no safeguard against time. I am concerned about a melt down or a leak with obvious implications, about evacuation and the million lives it would affect. I am concerned about waste disposal. Even disregarding human error as a problem - we already have a waste disposal problem - a nerve gas, chemical, nuclear waste disposal problem - no solutions have as yet been

tragedy in India, after three mile
island, in the wake of increasing

the present costs and the legacy of
your decision about Linerich. The
