(NRC INSPECTION REPORT NO. 50-395/92-10)

This refers to the inspection conducted by R. C. Haag of this office on May 1-31, 1992. The inspection included a review of activities authorized for your V. C. Summer Nuclear Facility. At the conclusion of the inspection, the findings were discussed with those members of your staff identified in the enclosed inspection report.

Areas examined during the inspection are identified in the report. Within these areas, the inspection consisted of selective examinations of procedures and representative records, interviews with personnel, and observation of activities in progress.

Based on the results of this inspection, certain of your activities appeared to be in violation of NRC requirements, as specified in the enclosed Notice of Violation (Notice). We are concerned about the first violation because of the failure to understand the effects of removing power to safety-related equipment and the weaknesses in controlling radiation monitor setpoints. For the second violation, we are concerned that the technical manual was not referred to during a maintenance activity on nuclear instrumentation for which a detailed maintenance procedure did not exist.

You are required to respond to this letter and should follow the instructions specified in the enclosed Notice when preparing your response. In your response, you should document the specific actions taken and any additional actions you plan to prevent recurrence. In addition to the violation response you should include a discussion on what improvements, if any, you intend for the degraded voltage protection system as referenced in paragraph 4 on page 7 of the attached inspection report.

In accordance with 10 CFR 2.790 of the NRC's "Rules of Practice," a copy of this letter and its enclosures will be placed in the NRC Public Document Room.
