On June 3-5, 1992, Mr. J. Laughlin and others from this office observed your full-participation emergency preparedness exercise. As noted in the enclosed report, we have concluded that this exercise demonstrated the on-site ability to protect the public health and safety.

Exercise strengths included effective command and control in the Emergency Response Facilities, staff interactions in diagnosing and mitigating accident conditions, and maintenance team deployment. No exercise weaknesses were identified.

Our findings were discussed with Mr. Drawbridge and other members of your staff at the inspection exit meeting.
