SUBJECT: SUSQUEHANNA - STATION BLACKOUT TEST (OELD # 841 643)

The no significant hazards consideration basis is very weak. In fact, when I first looked at it, I didn't understand how you could be making the argument you're making. However, when one looks at the explanation given in Generic Letter 83-24 for this, in light of what you say, you have a good, strong argument that it doesn't involve a significant hazard consideration. I would suggest that you add to the basis for the no significant hazards consideration an excerpt from Generic Letter 83-24. I suggest you add the same excerpt from 83-24 that the Licensee includes in his letter of December 9, 1983. I would add it at the beginning of our statement of the basis for no significant hazards determination.
