We have received your response of November 8, 1984, to our Notice of Violation issued on October 9, 1984, concerning activities conducted at your Hatch facility. Subsequent to the implementation of your stated corrective actions to ensure that systems are properly returned to service, the "keep-full" jockey pump system was improperly aligned.

The improper alignment of the jockey pump system (identified in Inspection Report 50-321 and 366/84-41 as an example to Violation 84-41-01) indicates that your corrective actions are not adequate to preclude further occurences of this nature.

It is therefore requested that you address this matter as part of your response to Violation 84-41-01.
