I. SECY-85-18 - Motion for Stay of Low-Power Authorization and Suspension of Low-Power License

The Commission, by a 4-0* vote, with Commissioner Asselstine not participating, approved an order denying a motion by Limerick Ecology Action to stay the Atomic Safety and Licensing Board decision, LBP-84-31, that authorized issuance of a low-power license for the Limerick Generating Station.

(Subsequently, on February 19, 1985 the Secretary signed the Order.)

II. Request for Stay in Shoreham

The Commission, by a vote of 4-1,** Commissioner Asselstine disapproving, approved a portion of the order denying a request of the State of New York and Suffolk County for a stay of the Commission's February 12, 1985 authorization for low power operation for the Shoreham Nuclear Power Plant.

By a vote of 4-1 the Commission, with Commissioner Roberts disapproving, also approved an extension of the effective date of the Commission's February 12, 1985 ruling until 5:00 p.m. on February 25, 1985.

(Subsequently, on February 14, 1985 the Secretary signed the Order.)
